“Minerva Owl team” from ICT Mahidol won first prize from the “1st JobberHack Challenge”



On May 5, 2020, the Minerva Owl team, which is comprised of Mr. Apakorn Kengkanna, a 4th year student, Miss Vipawan Jarukitpipat, and Mr. Pada Kanchanapinpong, 3rd year students from the Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University (ICT Mahidol), won first prize from the “1st JobberHack Challenge”.
