Duration:

Eligibility:

- 3rd year students (preferable from SE track)
- interested in SE research
- Cum. GPA ≥ 3.5
- Good English writing and speaking skills
- Strong commitment on continuing his/her research to achieve a substantial output (e.g., a publication) after finishing the internship.
- The students may be asked to continue his/her internship research project as a senior project.
- For those who are interested in joining the program, but GPA is lower than 3.5, you can send an application with the supports of the qualification (e.g. one-page proposal, evidences showing that you have a strong programming skill).

Number of acceptances:

Maximum 3 positions

Living expenses:

Daily expenses for the total of 138,500 JPY

Accommodation:

NAIST supports the dormitory in the campus for approximately 2 months (64,500 JPY).

Scholarships:

The students will automatically receive the scholarship when selected for the program in the form of dallying living expenses. The students can also apply for Scholarship for Undergraduate Student Mobility Program 2020 from Mahidol University (more detail:
