ICT Mahidol students have completed their remote summer internship with the Software Engineering research group at Nara Institute of Science and Technology

Prof. Dr. Raula Gaikovina Kula, Prof. Dr. Kenichi Matsumoto, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Takashi Ishio, and NAIST graduate students in the group. On the ICT side, Asst. Prof. Dr. Thanwadee Sunetnanta, Dr. Morakot Choetkiertikul, and Dr. Chaiyong Ragkhitwetsagul co-supervised the students. The summer internship occurred from 7 June to 6 August 2021. The Faculty of ICT has offered this summer internship opportunity for ICT students for several years with strong connections with the Software Engineering research group at NAIST.
