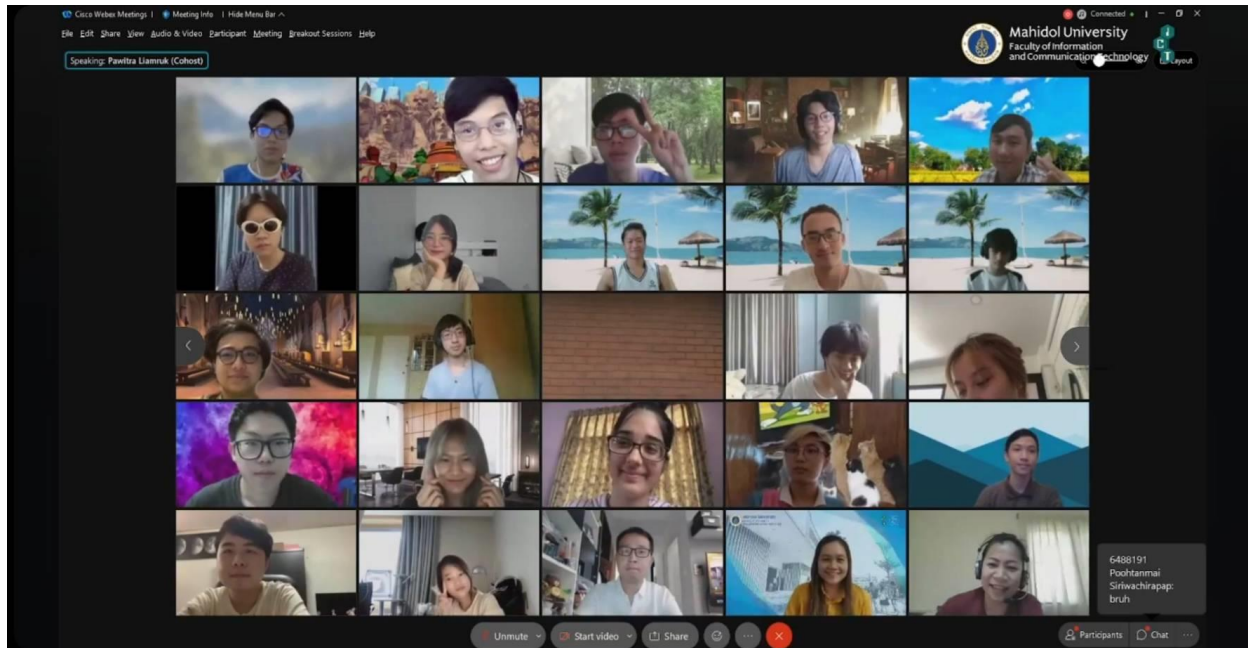




## Activity News

### ICT Mahidol held an online event, “New ICT Undergraduate Student Orientation for Academic Year 2021”



On 4 August 2021 – Dr. Pattanasak Mongkolwat, Dean of the Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University (ICT Mahidol), together with Dr. Pawitza Liamruk, Deputy Dean for Academic Administration, and Acting Deputy Dean for Organizational Communication and Engagement, held an online event “New ICT Undergraduate Student Orientation for Academic Year 2021” for its freshmen from its 2 programs: Information and Communication Technology (ICT, International Program) as well as Digital Science and Technology (DST, Thai Program), via Webex Meetings and Facebook Live.
