ICT Mahidol organized “ICT Mahidol Online Short Course: Learning Arduino Programming with Simulator” for high school students via Gather.Town



On 30 June 2022 - the Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University (ICT Mahidol), led by Asst. Nattachart Tamkittikhun, instructor, Mr. Radchapol Eianleng, and Mr. Tamakorn Jiamrachada, 3rd year students of ICT International program, organized “ICT Mahidol Online Short Course: Learning Arduino Programming with Simulator” for 26 high school students via Gather.Town.

During the session, the instructors demonstrated how to program and use the Arduino. The Arduino is a user-friendly microcontroller board that can be easily modified and developed.
