During the session, Dr. Jens Krinke shared knowledge and research experience regarding copying code from software projects or online sources, especially Stack Overflow which is the world's largest community for worldwide programmers. The speaker also stated that codes obtained from Stack Overflow can become toxic code snippets, e.g., being bugged and outdated, or violating the original software license.
