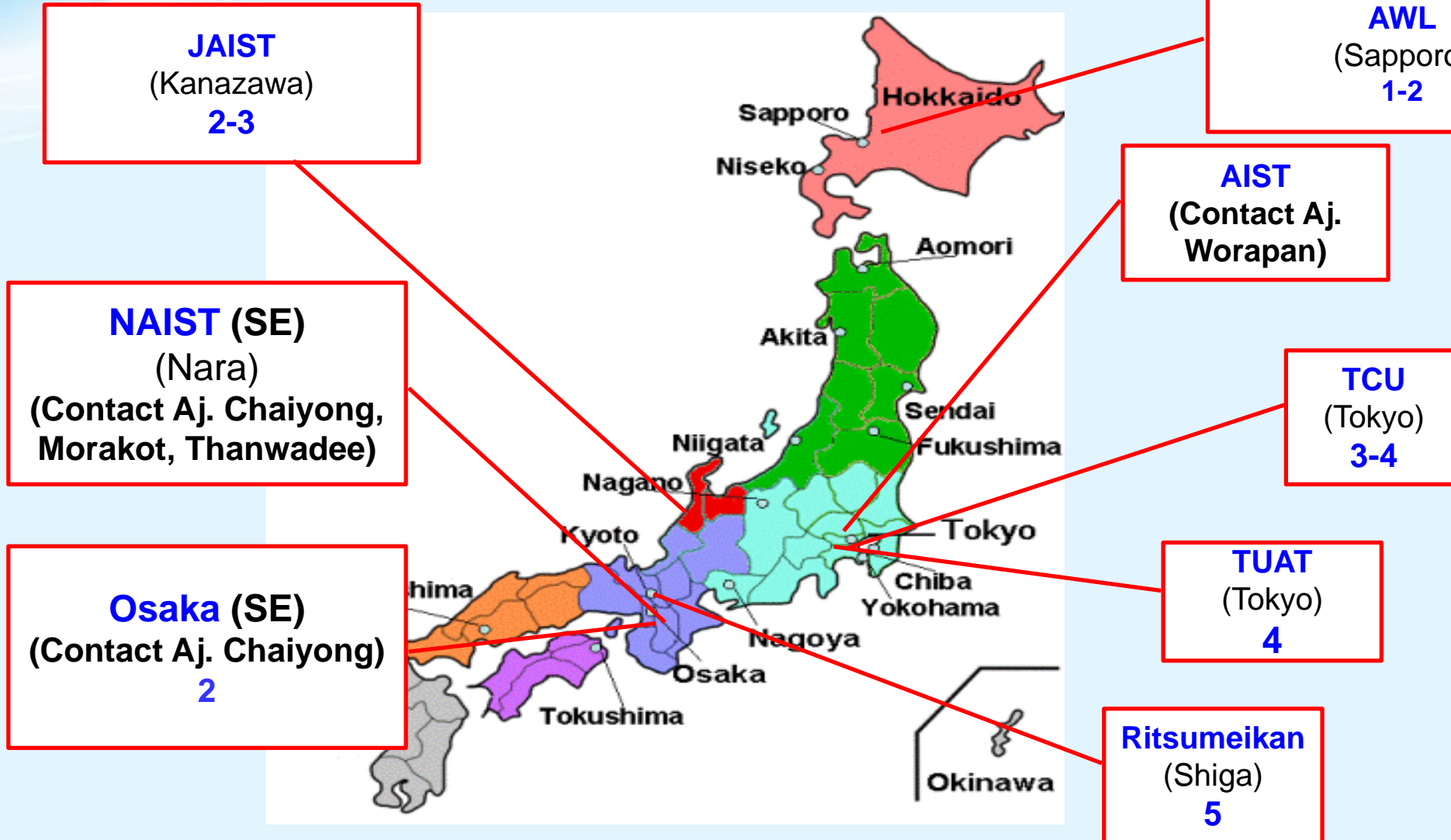

Conditions for Japan Internship

1. Every student who receives support from Japan side must write a conference paper after returning back to Thailand
 - Faculty will support up to **10,000 BHT** for conference registration fee, ticket fare, and accommodation.
2. If you and your advisor consider to extend the internship topic as the senior project by continuing the co-research with Japanese researchers, the chance for being selected as a Japan internship will be higher.
3. We will give priority to students who really want to study graduate programs at the host university.

Number of acceptance:

- 4 students in any track will receive **JASSO scholarship** (~80,000 JPY/month * 3 months) = **240,000 JPY in total**)
- GPA must be above 3.2
- **Duration: Fri 26 May - Fri 4 Aug 2023 (71 days)**
- Requirements: (1) Write one international Conference paper
(2) If possible, wish to do the master degree at TUAT
- Accommodation: ~80,000 JPY/month*2 months
- Food: ~40,000 JPY/month/person

(Normally, 240,000 JPY from Jasso can cover the dorm and air plane ticket + etc.

You have to pay for the food around **30,000 THB**; You can receive further funding from Mahidol Undergrad Exchange Scholarship)



About Dormitory

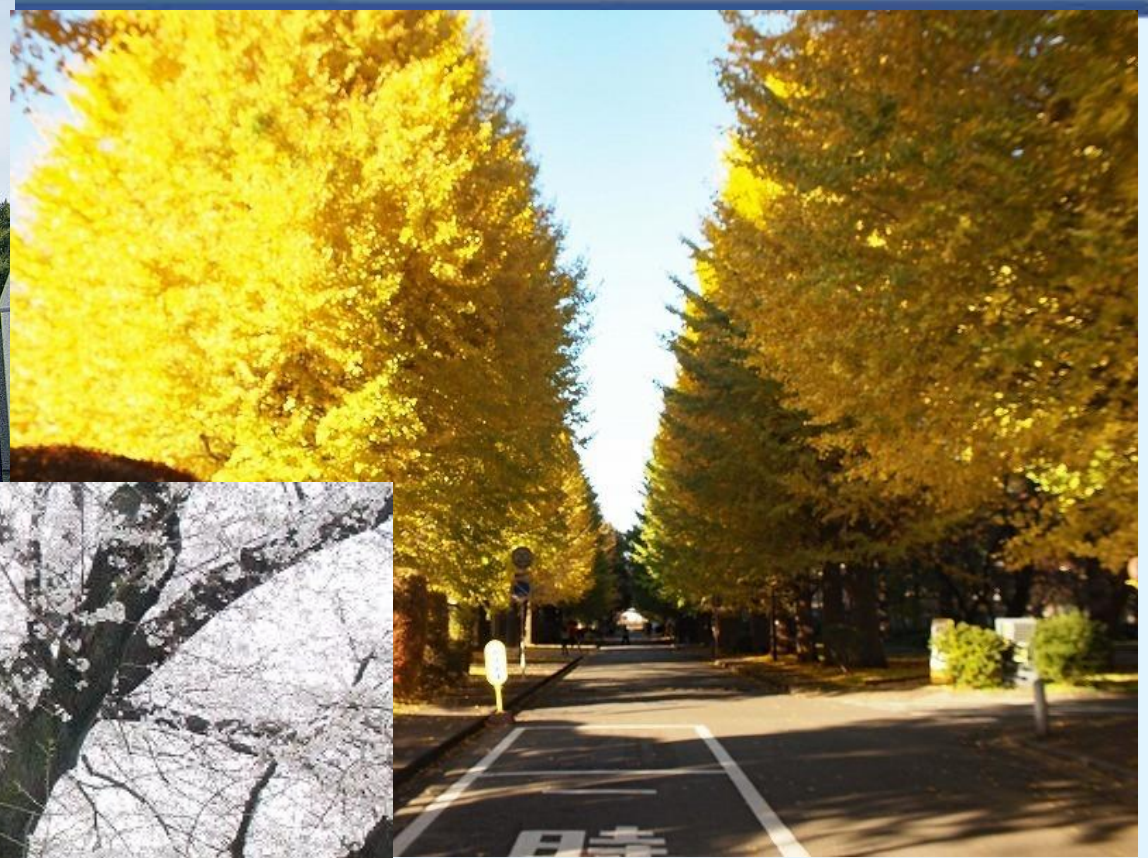
- You have to find the dormitory by yourself.

Research: Faculty of Knowledge Engineering

Support: None (but they will help finding an apartment around the campus)

Duration: June – July 2023 (60 days)

- Air ticket: 15,000 THB
- Accommodation: 80,000 Yen/month*2 months (~44,000 THB)
- Food: ~50,000 Yen/month *2 months (~27,500 THB)
- **Total: ~83,500 THB in total** (can receive **25,000 THB** from MU student mobility scholarship)

Support:

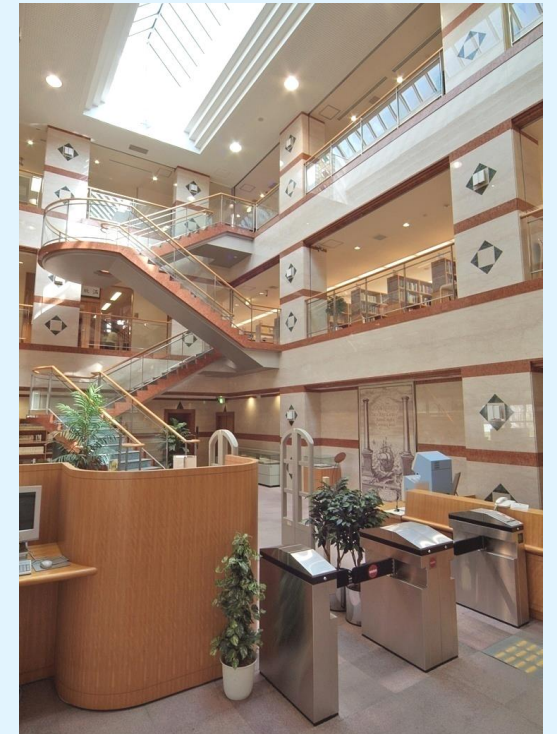

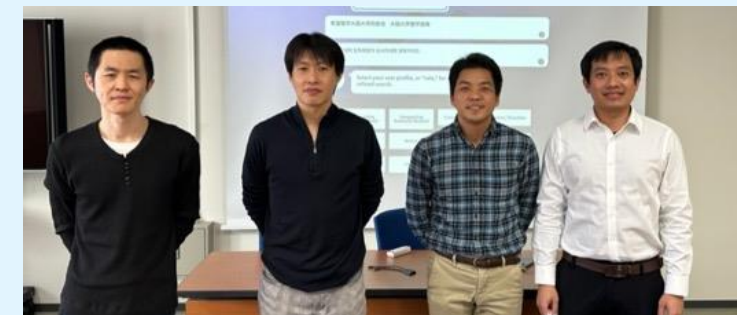

- **Higo Lab** (<https://sel.ist.osaka-u.ac.jp>) → Contact: Aj. Chaiyong
- **Number of acceptance:** 2 students (preferably) in SE track
- **Requirement:** CGPA ≥ 3.25 (lower grade can send an additional 1-page proposal for consideration)
- **Research Topics:** Code analysis, automated program repair
- **Support:** Students with CPGA ≥ 2.75 can apply for Mahidol Student Mobility Scholarship (maximum 60,000 THB)
- **Duration:** June – July (approx. 2 months)
 - You have to pay for Flight Ticket and Foods by yourself
 - Flight ticket: ~20,000 THB
 - Food: ~40,000 Yen/month/person (~ 13,000 THB*2 months)
