ICT Mahidol instructor served as a guest speaker in the knowledge-sharing activity, "Preparedness and Response to Cybersecurity Incidents in the Phayathai Area"



On July 3 and 19, 2023, Lect. Pagaporn Pengsart, Deputy Dean for Infrastructure and Technology, Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University (ICT Mahidol), along with Dr. Nawanan Theera-Ampornpunt, M.D., Deputy Dean for Operations, Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital, Mahidol University, as the representative of the head of the Phaya Thai Area Management Continuity Committee, served as guest speakers. On this occasion, they provided their knowledge and insights on, "Preparedness and Response to Cybersecurity Incidents in the Phaya Thai Area".
