The event was also held online via Webex Meetings.

- Assoc. Prof. Dr. Worapan Kusakunniran, an Instructor of the Computer Science Group, and Head of Machine Vision and Information Transfer Lab (MVIT) at the Faculty of ICT, lectured on "AI in Medical Imaging."
- Asst. Prof. Narit Hnoohom, Chair of the Computer Engineering Department at the Faculty of Engineering, gave a lecture on "Everyday AI."

Following the talk, there was a panel discussion moderated by Dr. Tipajin Thaipisitukul, Assistant Dean for Academic Services and Technology Transfer, the Faculty of ICT, and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Thanapat Wanichanon, Vice Dean for Strategy and Human Capital Management, the Faculty of Engineering, Mahidol University.
